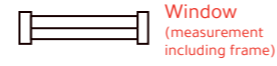

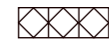

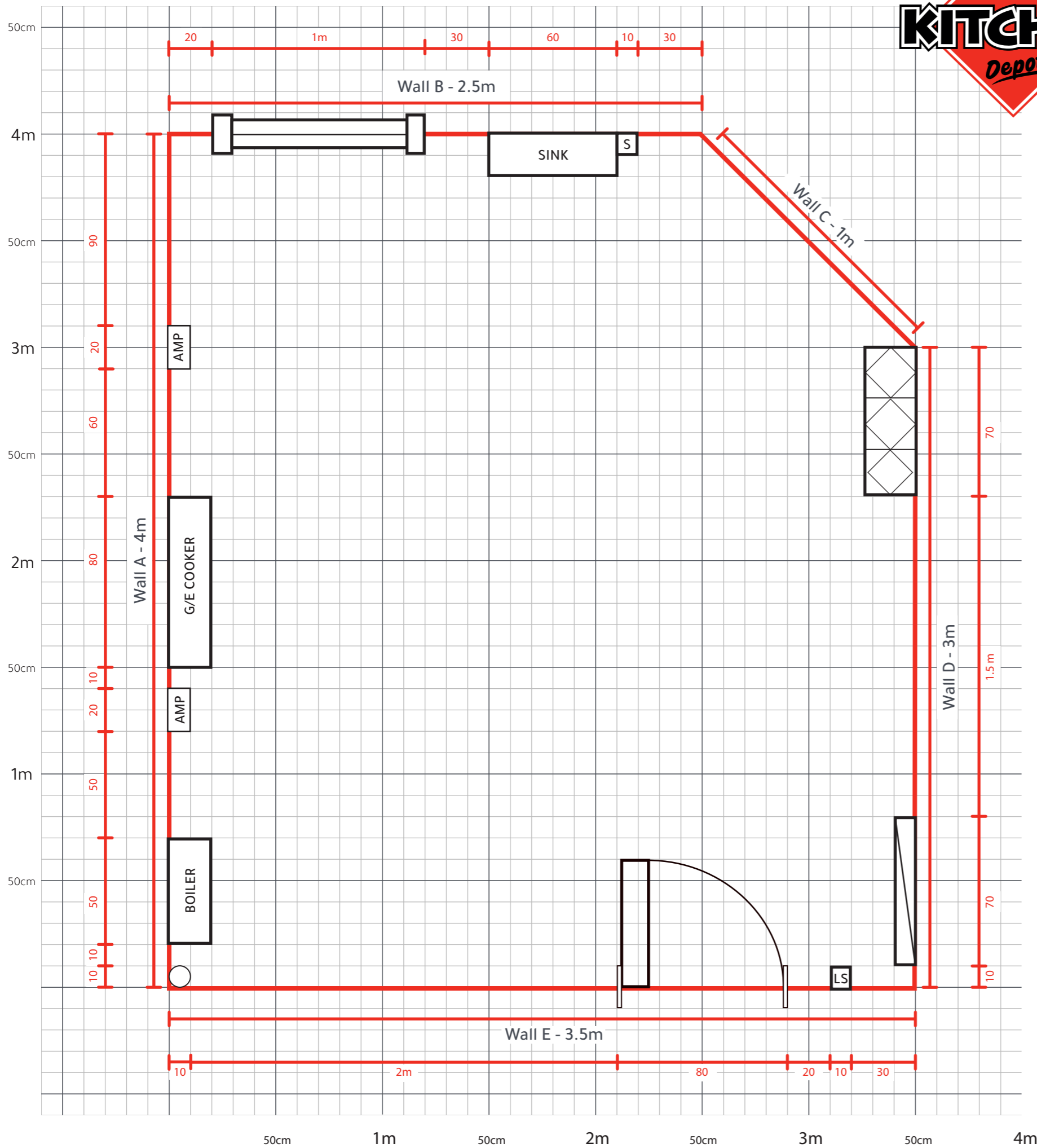

- 1 Starting from the bottom left corner, draw the shape of the room and add wall measurements on the outside of the lines.
- 2 Measure and draw windows, doors, radiators, pipes and any other obstacles in the room. Using the Key on the previous page.
- 3 Add utilities such as sockets and gas, water and electric supplies.
- 4 Double check all measurements, make sure that all the smaller measurements equal the total wall length.
